

Press Release for Remembrance Sunday and Armistead Day

Remembrance Sunday 8th November 2009 at 10am, meeting at St James School Car Park and Armistead Day 11th November 2009, Meeting at the Gazebo at 10:45am

The Remembrance Parade on Sunday 8th November 2009 will comprise the British Legion, the Town Mayor, Town Councillors, the Chairman of Daventry District Council, District Councillors, Army Cadets, Air Cadets, together with representatives from the Girls Brigade, Boys Brigade, Scouts, Guides, Cubs and Brownies.

The parade route will start at St James School car park at 10:00am moving on to Tavern Lane, High Street, and Abbey Street and on to The War Memorial. A service at Holy Cross Church will take place after the commemoration at the War Memorial and then it is a march back along the route to St James School where the parade will disperse.

Everyone taking part in the parade will be welcome to refreshments at Casey's Club after the church service.

The commemorative service at the Gazebo on Wednesday 11th November, will commence at 10:45 ready to for all those gathered, to share the traditional two minutes silence, starting with a bugle call of 'Last Post' followed by 'Reveille' and a short service to remember those that have taken part in the two World Wars.
