Historic Signage

Daventry Local History Group has approached the Town Council with a request to support their aim to promote the history of Daventry through the provision of street signs to be placed on streets of historic interest.

With the expansion of Daventry the Local History Group believes that the importance of the Town's past should not be forgotten. In order to achieve this, the group is looking into funding for street signs and plaques which will give information about the former use of various sites now occupied by new buildings.

The Town Council gives its full support for this endeavour and looks forward to hearing more from the Local History Group.

Signage to Places of Interest

The Town Council will be looking to resolve this issue with both Daventry District Council and Northampton County Council.
