### **Remembrance Day Parade 8<sup>th</sup> November 2009**

The Remembrance Day Parade will be held on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2009.

Those who wish to join the parade should meet at St James School car park at 10:00am. The Parade will leave from St James School at 10:30am, moving on to Tavern Lane, High Street, and Abbey Street and finally to the War Memorial.

There will then be an act of remembrance at the War Memorial, followed by a service at Holy Cross Church. The Parade will then march back to St James School and then disperse.

### **Armistice Day 11<sup>th</sup> November 2009**

A commemorative service will be held at the Gazebo, at 11:00 on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2009. Anyone wishing to attend should gather at 10:45 to be ready to share the traditional two minutes silence, starting with a bugle call of 'Last Post' followed by 'Reveille' and a short service to remember those that fought and gave their lives in recent and past wars.
