

**UPDATED**  
**Important Notice**  
**to all DTC Allotment Holders**  
*Relating to COVID-19*

Further to recent changes in Government guidance on 'Staying Alert and Safe (Social Distancing)', Daventry Town Council has reviewed and amended its guidelines (amendments in red):

- Any allotment holder in receipt of direction to isolate for 12 weeks **must** follow this instruction and **not** go to the allotments – Stay at Home.
- All allotment holders must observe social distancing (2-3 metres).
- No more than two **ADULTS (from the same household) are allowed per plot.**
- **Adults can be accompanied by young children, but they must remain on their plot and observe social distancing at all times.**
- **Use hand sanitizer and/or anti-bac wipes when opening and closing gates or when touching communal surfaces.**
- Do not wash your hands in the water troughs.

The rules on social distancing and cleansing of common surfaces are extremely important in protecting the vulnerable and preventing the spread of the virus.

**PLEASE NOTE: ALLOTMENT TENANTS WHO DO NOT FOLLOW THE RULES  
WILL HAVE THEIR TENANCY TERMINATED.**
